The clear globes you see are a physical representation of the shared journey of the children of Arapaho UMC through the liturgical calendar.

- The first globe contains ashes prepared by the children from last year's Palm Sunday which were used to adorn the foreheads of the faithful at this year's Ash Wednesday - February 10.
- There will be six globes containing purple tissue paper hearts that have been torn in half. These hearts represent all of the things that interfere in our relationship with God; they are torn because we have given them to God during Lent - February 14, 21, 28, March 6, 13, 20.



- There will be one globe containing red tissue paper hearts. These hearts are whole, and represent what God is calling us to do on Pentecost Sunday and beyond - May 15.
